SEVILLA

Sevilla is a “must see” locations due to its mild Mediterranean climate and rich culture, an embodiment to the true essence Andalusia. This city, with its beautiful whitewashed buildings, small balconies overflowing with geraniums, countless historic buildings and quiet winding streets, is an ideal place to learn Spanish.

From a historical standpoint, Sevilla is exceedingly rich. For example, the Cathedral, built in the 1400's is perhaps the most impressive Gothic cathedral in the Christian world. It adjoins an Almohad Tower, called the Giralda, which originally was the minaret of the Great Mosque. This 300 foot high tower has become a symbol of the city. Across the plaza from the Cathedral stands the Alcazar, an impressive 10th century palace complex featuring excellent examples of both Moorish and Christian architecture. Beyond these, the city contains many other historic sites, all very much worth a visit.

While these inspiring and historic sites are the backdrops of everyday life in modern Sevilla, The bustling commercial center is filled with typical business and trade activities, and an efficient public transportation system. Visitors will also find that sevillanos are a gracious and social people always welcoming visitors to their city. Which means, for someone who wants to experience Southern Spain, Sevilla is an excellent choice!

PROGRAM OPTIONS

Standard Program. Group instruction, 4 lessons per day, 6-12 students max per class. In total there are 20 classes of Spanish and 2 culture classes per week, with rotating teachers. These classes meet from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. M-F, as well as from 2:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. during high season.

Intensive Program. This is designed for small groups with 4 lessons per day, and 3-6 students per class. This course is for those who have a limited time available or need to practice as much as possible. The difference between the standard course and this one is that the maximum number of students per group is 6 and there is more time to practice your Spanish and more direct contact with your teachers. These classes meet from 9:15 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., M-F.

Super-Intensive Program. Small group instruc-

tion, 6 lessons per day, 3-6 students per class. This course is for those who have little time available, or who are highly motivated and need to advance rapidly in a short space of time. These classes meet from 9:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., M-F.

Intensive Plus. Group classes meet from 9:15 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., then you switch to private lessons from 1:30 p.m. to 3:10 p.m., M-F. If you are looking for a great intensive program, this is course is an excellent selection.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All the accommodations are located no more than 20 minutes on foot from the School. Linen is provided with each accommodation, please bring your own bath towels.

Residence. Stately Sevillian houses within walking distance, double or single rooms, TV, kitchen, shared bathrooms and terraces. Cleaning service included.

Homestay. Most students eat with the family and in this way have a direct and natural experience with Spanish lifestyles. We recommend this option for younger students who want to experience a true Spanish atmosphere. Two meals a day are included.

Furnished Apartment. Centrally-located flat for oneortwopeople, withkitchenandbathroom. CLIC also offers executive accommodations as well.

Private Apartment. All our flats are furnished and have a living room, fully equipped kitchen and bathroom. Most apartments are studio flats with twin beds or a double bed. There are also luxury flats available. House cleaning, electricity, and water are not included.

Shared Apartment. Bedrooms are simply furnished and can either be single or double. You will normally have 1-2 foreign students with 1-2 native students. This option allows students to live quite independently as well as have contact with Spanish people at the same time. Students are expected to share all household chores and facilities.
